STUDENTS

Before

- Learn what to expect and what to do during an emergency
- Identify hazards in the classroom, school, home
- Participate in earthquake drills
- Know a safe place to reach
- Prepare an identification tag for you with your name, parents name, teachers name and address. Keep it with you all the time

During

- Follow teacher's instructions
- Take cover under a desk or table
- If out of the classroom, run to an open place
- Try not to panic

After

- Follow evacuation instructions from teacher or designated monitor
 - Put on identification tag
 - Comfort and reassure other students
 - Do not re-enter school without permission
 - Do not go home without permission; be aware that your parent/guardian may be delayed in coming for you
 - Talk about what has happened
 - Cooperate with teachers and task forces
 - Help in rescue of your friends and other who need help
 - As soon as possible contact you parents or teachers to tell them that you are fine.
